In this two day class, students will learn how to make two different large sugar flowers. You will learn how to make Jacqueline's large open peony with stamens and also the beautiful tulip. This is a great class if you want to learn more about wiring petals, as larger flowers are frequently made with multiple individual petals taped together to create a single, stunning bloom. Students will then use beautiful dusting colors to give their flowers a gorgeous finish.
